PRESS STATEMENT
12th September, 2025

Hon'ble PM is arriving in Manipur on 13th September, 2025. On his arrival at Churachandpur at about 11.30 am, he will first interact with the Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) in the district. He will lay Foundation Stone of various infrastructural projects to be taken up throughout the State at Peace Ground, Churachandpur and will also address the public gathering present there.

Thereafter, he will arrive at Kangla around 2.00 pm and interact with the IDPs. The Hon'ble Prime Minister will be inaugurating various developmental projects within and outside the State (belonging to Manipur) and will also address the public gathering present there.

The details of the projects worth Rs. 7,300 crore for which Foundation Stones are being laid and the projects worth Rs. 1,200 crore being inaugurated are provided separately.

Such initiatives underscore the Hon'ble Prime Minister's continued commitment and dedication for the development and welfare of the State. Thus, I, on behalf of the Government of Manipur and the Government of India, request the people of Manipur, to come forward in welcoming the Hon'ble Prime Minister to the State and participate in the programme.
